May, Sunday 29

Clear and warm days and cool nights We all went to meeting to day [sic] up to Father Holts School house and we staid [sic] to Sunday School after meeting Brother took the lead of the Sunday School for to day [sic]

May, Monday 30

Warmer this morning went to wash sheep down to [illegible] creek Mr Bowdish went down and helped me wash and when I came back by Fitchburgh and by Squares to tell him about Mary's barn raiseing [sic] next Wednesday

May, Tuesday 31

Clear and very warm and dry cool nights and heavy [sic] dews To day [sic] finished moving [sic] fence and laying it over and finished the fence clear through [Turned?] the hogs into the field had a sow that had pigs she had but four
