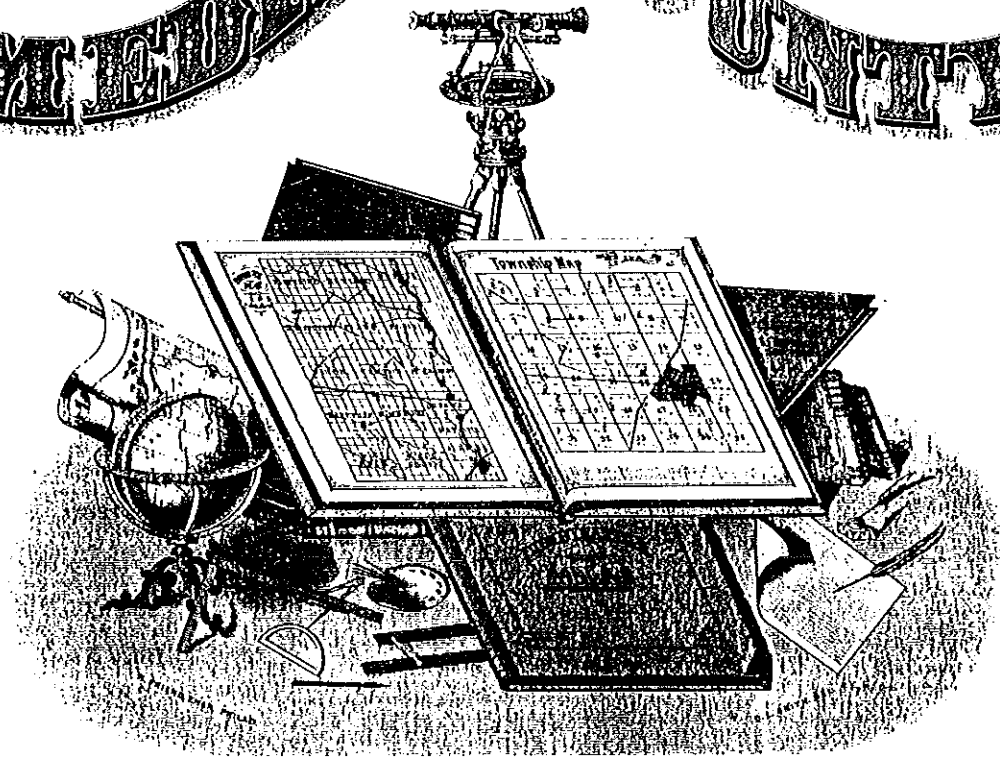

MCLELLAN COUNTY



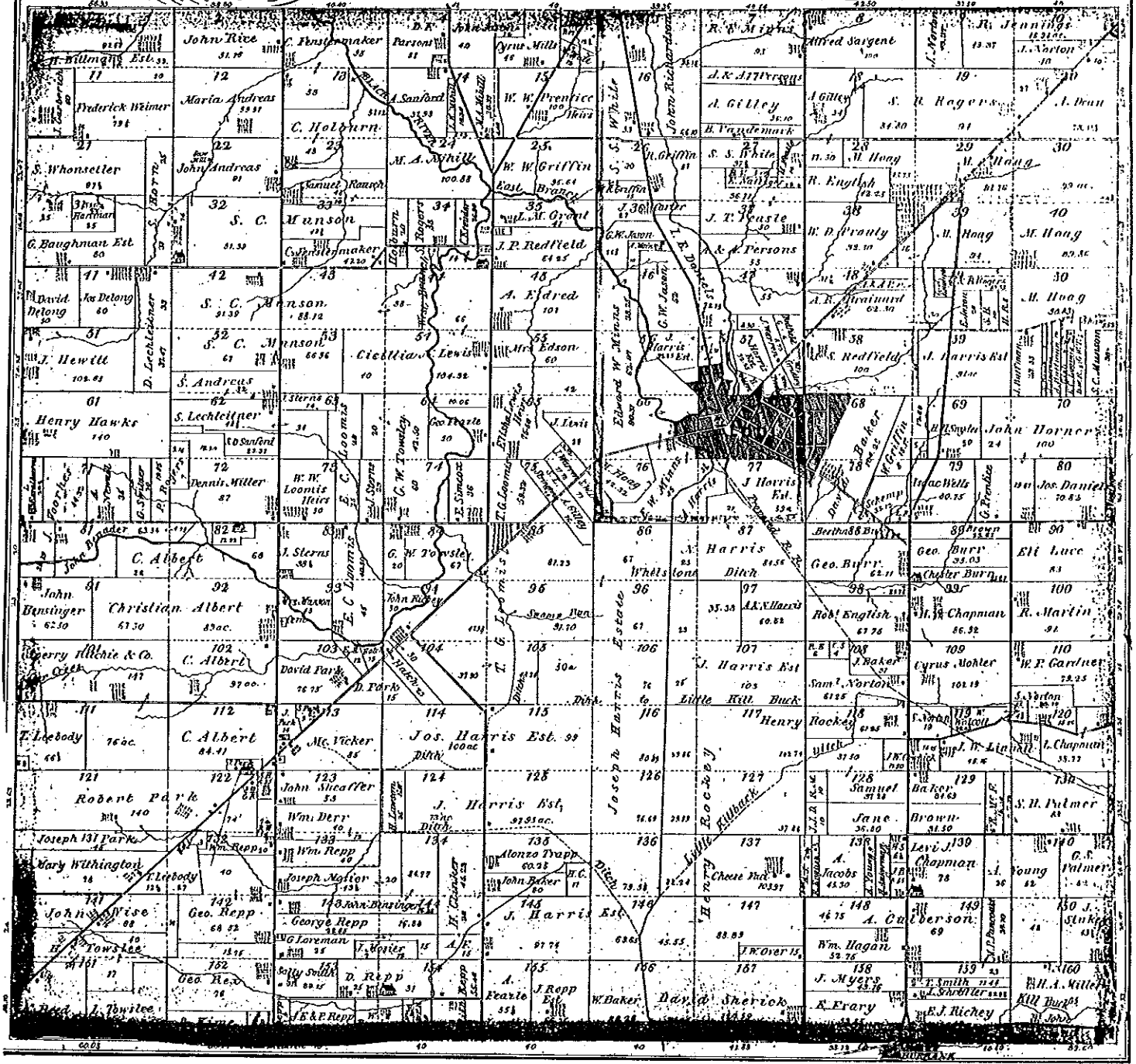



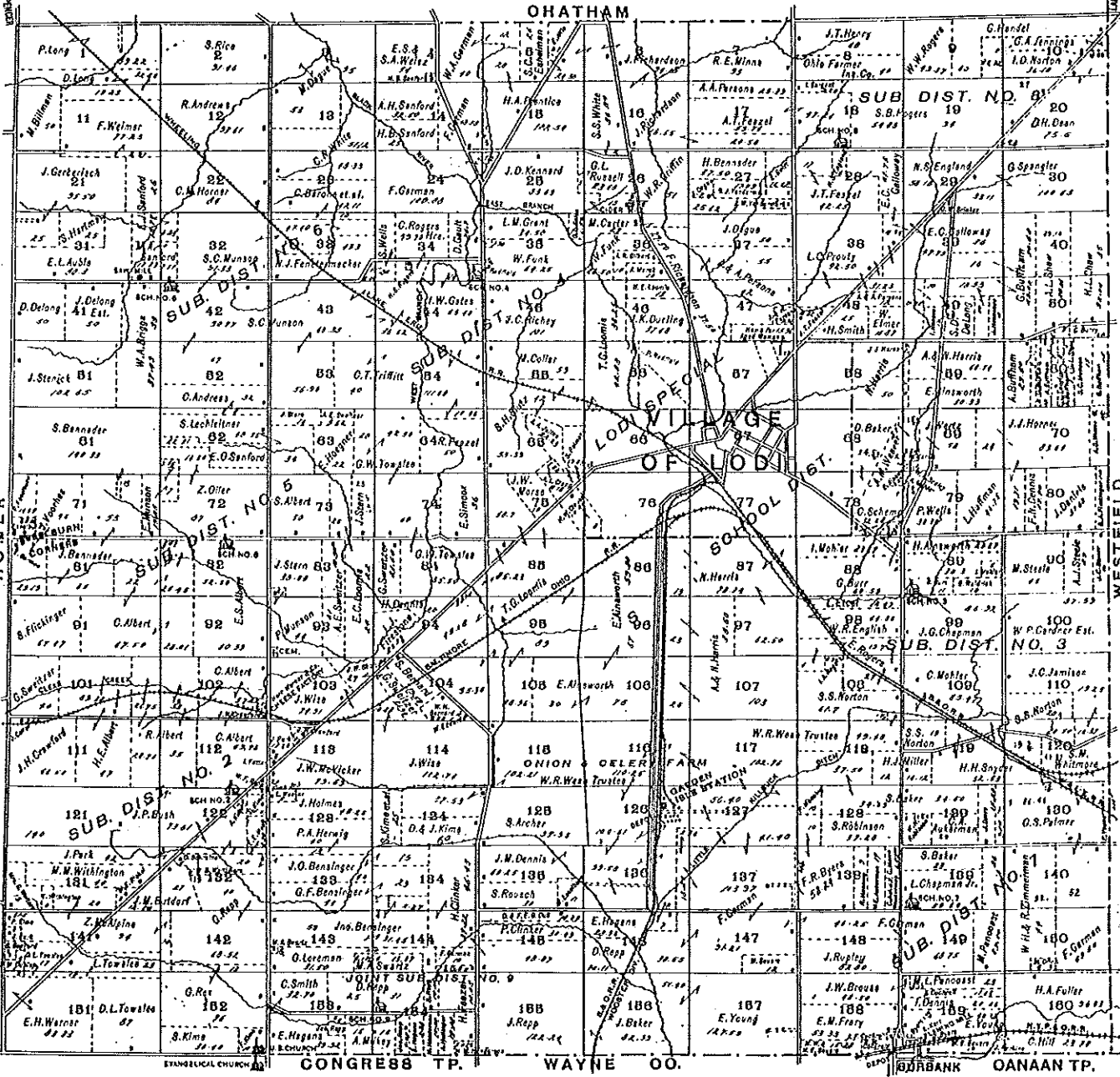

And that there is now due and owing to said defendant, Christian Adleman, from the estate of said Levi J.
