Obituary—Halderman

Frank M. Halderman, better known as Mac, son of Levi and Marthaetta Halderman, was born at Lancaster, Ohio, April 13, 1862, and departed this life at his home at Long Island, April 20, 1936 at the age of 74 years, and 7 days.
