I was really lucky as a lot of the fellows leave this camp Sat [Saturday] some go to Fort Bliss Texas some to Fort Sheridan Illinois they are much farther from home-that I wouldn't like. I will be in Btrg [building?] C, 69th but I don't know the real address yet. I have been thinking if no one goes to Polish park anymore I guess we will have to start going somewhere else to just so that some of the gang go there also. It doesn't look like I will be home this weekend boy I wished I were as I will be leaving all to soon anyway probally [sic] overseas too. That I hope never comes.
