A physical check was made by me of the cemetery records and the gravestones on 19 June 1991, at West Union, Iowa.

1. A discrepancy appears with the date in the record and that upon the stone for Adaline. The record had Jan. 8, 1899 but her stone has Jan. 6, which is the correct date of her death. The record for Franklin H. has Dec. 5, 1906, his death occurred on 30 Nov. 1906. The dates given in the records are not designated as either death or funeral dates so in this case would seem to be funeral dates.
