Andrew Elliott was born in 1772 in Ireland. He settled in Holmes County, Ohio. His wife was Elizabeth Finlay. His brother William Elliott born 1780 moved to Ohio settling first in Jefferson County and then in Wayne County about 1827. He married Elizabeth Hays. Other Elliott families in Jefferson County Ohio include Thomas Elliott who died in 1819 and Robert Elliott who died in 1816.
