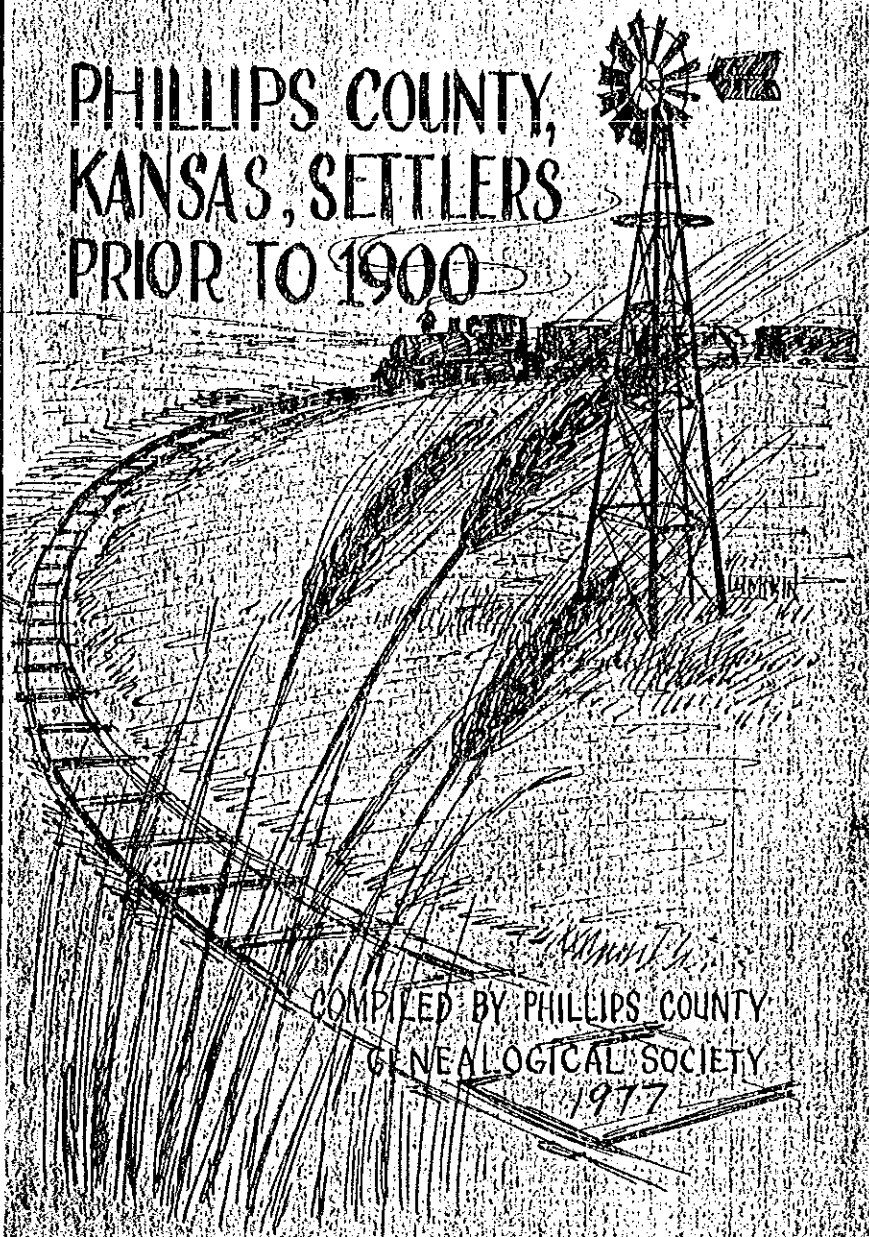

he enlisted in Company A, Tenth Illinois Cavalry (Civil War) and served until June 17, 1865. A member of the G.A.R. his name appears on the Roll of Post No. 77.

On March 12, 1861 in Licking County Ohio, he married Matilda Ann Davis, daughter of David E. and Ruth (Sheppard) Davis. She was born January 19, 1841, at Athens, Illinois.

Thomas Larkin died August 4, 1908, at Phillipsburg. His wife Matilda died April 16, 1909, in Denver, Colorado. They are buried at Phillipsburg.

## PENNINGTON

Allen Jefferson Pennington, son of Thomas Jefferson Pennington and his wife Polly Vawter, was born Aug. 3, 1837, in Industry, Illinois. He was the grandson of John Stewart Pennington and his wife Jamina Houser, and the great-grandson of Richard Pennington and his wife Hannah Boone, sister to Daniel Boone.

Allen Pennington was the last of five children born to the union of his parents. His mother died on his third birthday. His father remarried, to a widow, Mary Jane Smithers Rogers. Eight more children were born.

Allen enlisted in military service at Clear Creek, Mississippi, Dec. 20, 1863, serving in Co. I, H Cavalry Regiment Volunteers, and was discharged on Aug. 24, 1865.

On Feb. 23, 1869, he married Jane Randolph Knowles of Macomb, Ill. She was born Nov. 2, 1842, in Industry, Ill., and was descended from the Randolphs of Virginia.

In March 1875, Allen and Jane Pennington and two sons headed west. They stopped at Seward, Nebraska, and rented a farm. There a daughter was born. Shortly thereafter, the

family loaded up and headed for Kansas. On Oct. 10, 1875, they arrived at their homestead on Plum Creek in Greenwood Township, in Phillips County, thirteen and one-half miles northeast of Phillipsburg.

During the period the house was being built, the family stayed with the Jim Tomberlins. Jim Tomberlin's sister Susan married Stewart McKendra "Dick" Pennington, who was Allen's half-brother. The new house was a dugout with a stone front facing east, with a fine fireplace with a raised hearth, built by "Dick." Jane Pennington was a dedicated housekeeper whose shiny nickel coffee and tea pots are still remembered by her grandchildren. In 1876, a card came from the freight office in Republican City, Nebraska, notifying the family of freight received from Dr. Gilbert Knowles, of McQuon, Ill. He was a brother to Jane. The barrel proved to contain a service for twelve of semi-porcelain Haviland dishes, with a blackberry pattern.

In 1836, the Penningtons built a new frame home. It had a full basement, with walls of smooth-cut rectangular stone. It had two rooms downstairs and two rooms upstairs connected by a narrow, winding staircase leading to a short central hallway. It was painted white inside and out, with green shutters. Dave Potts, a local carpenter, built the house for \$75.00 of the total \$500.00 cost. It was considered quite a show-place.

In Sept. 1920, Allen Jefferson Pennington and his wife, Jane moved from the farm to Phillipsburg, where on July 29, 1923, Jane died. Allen died Oct. 11, 1928. Both were buried at Pleasant Valley Cemetery in Greenwood Township.

James Thomas was born Jan. 17, 1870, near Industry, Ill. He married Maude Whitney. They moved to Del Norte, Colorado, where they raised a family of eight children and lived out their lives.

Allen Jefferson II, called "Jeff", was born Dec. 13, 1872, near Industry, Ill. On Nov. 1, 1898, he married Rosa May Judd. The Rev. Isaac Johnson officiated at his home in the Hillside neighborhood. Four children were born. Mr. Jeff Pennington died Nov. 28, 1951, at Phillipsburg.

Elizabeth Burgess (born Mar. 17, 1837) and her sister came from Scotland to visit America when their father gave them \$1500 to make the voyage. They liked this country so much that they decided to stay; and they started a dress shop. Later Elizabeth met William M. Ferguson and on Mar. 27, 1855, in Pennsylvania married him.

William was born Jan. 16, 1833, in Pittsburg, Penn. His father was John McLain Ferguson born in Scotland. William was a teacher in Pennsylvania. Later he and his wife decided to move west. They came to Phillips County, Ks., about 1875 and homesteaded seven miles north and
