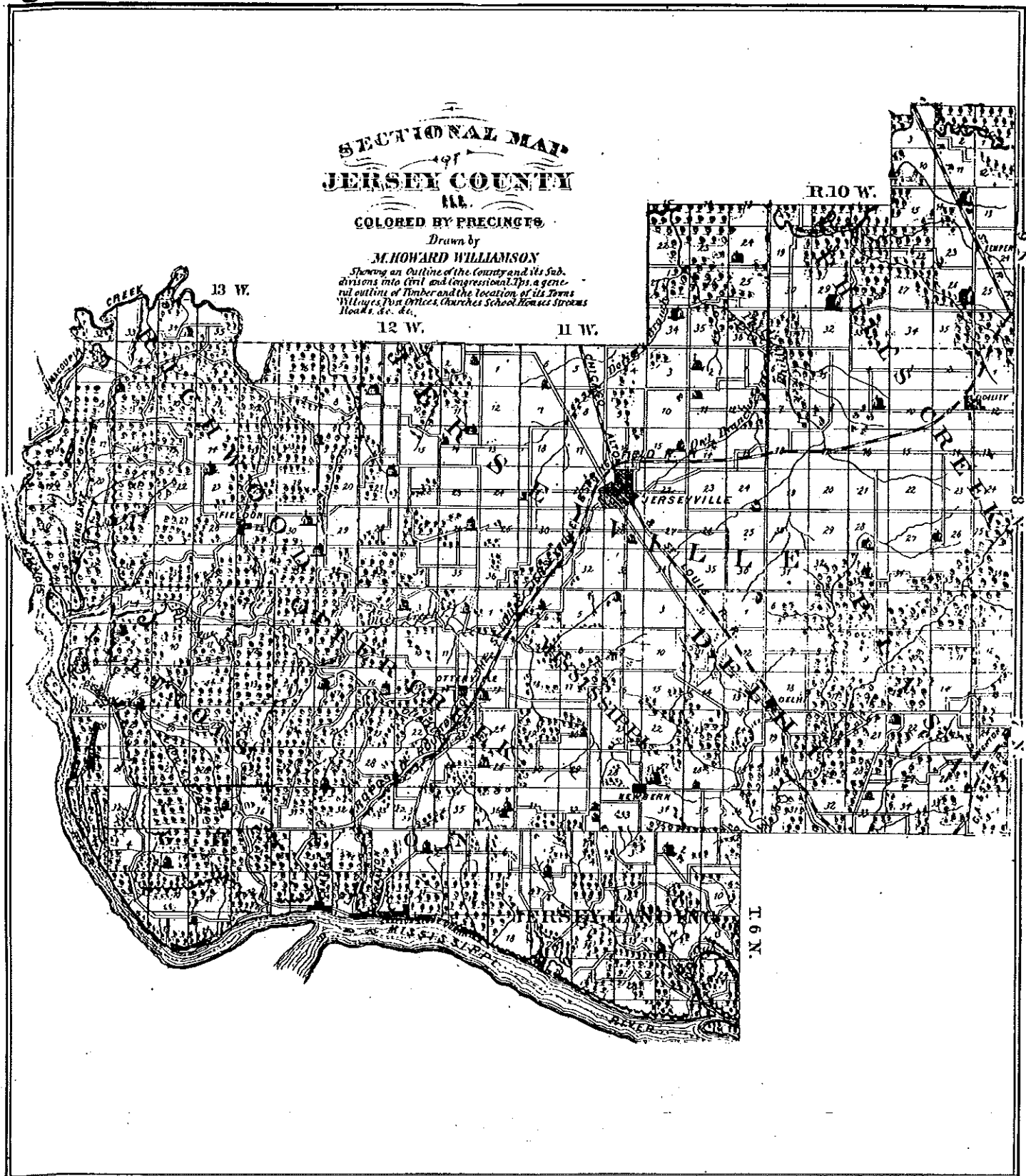
SECTIONAL MAP
