after supper but it looked like rain  
Square sent after Samantha for Stela [sic] was  
sick

June, Sunday 5

Looks some like rain it rained  
a little in the forenoon Went  
over to Squares took Lina and  
Winnie with me staid [stayed] till after  
dinner and then went to Sunday  
School and then went after  
Samantha and the children  
Stella was quite sick and  
Emma was sick with the measels [sic]

June, Monday 6

Pleasant [sic] and very dry went  
to cultivating corn in the  
forenoon went to get another  
cultivator and Alpha went  
after it at noon in the after  
noon the boys went to work  
in the corn and I staid [stayed] in the  
house to help take care of Winnie for  
she was sick

June, Tuesday 7

Pleasant [sic] and a little cooler and  
cool nights Staid [stayed] in the house  
and helped take care of the childr  
-en [sic] in the forenoon while Saman  
-tha [sic] done her washing The boys  
was to work in the corn in the  
afternoon went to Fitchburgh to  
get some wool twine and groceries

June, Wednesday 8

Pleasant [sic] was to stay at the house  
to help take care of the children  
and the boys went to cultivating  
corn in the forenoon in the  
afternoon I went and cleared  
out the barn for sheep shearing  
I [sic] commenced to rain about two  
oclock [sic] and rained all the rest  
of the day and part of night
