OTTO LESTER CANTWELL, son of Joseph Edman and Frances Brandon Cantwell, was born April 8, 1904 in Bluff City, Kansas, and passed away May 25, 1974 in Anthony, Kansas, at the age of 70 years, 1 month and 17 days.

He spent his entire life in the Harper County and Manchester area.
