ADDENDUM

Spencer Y. & Alice (DOWD) WOOD Family

The 1910 Census of Pike County, Buffalo Township, State of Missouri, (Enum. Dist. No. 116. Sheet No. 4B) has recorded that Spencer and Alice have been married for 7 years and that she was the mother of 6 children of which 5 were living on 27 April 1910.

Starting with the eldest and in the order of their ages they were: Russell, Jesse, Mary & (Wilmer) (who appear to be twins) and Kermit, the youngest.

From another source Jesse, Kermit & Georgia are reported to have died at the same time of meningitis.

Russell died about 1969.

Pat died about 1971.

Out of their 18 children two sets of twins died at birth and also one infant died at birth which must be the one that died before the 1910 census.
