April, Sunday 3

Pleasant [sic] and windy did not go to meeting to day [sic] Alpha went Andrew was gone to [illegible] I staid [stayed] with Samantha and the children The weeks are passing swiftly away this year is one quarter is gone and soon our days will be numberd [sic] and we shall pass away from earth
