The Message made mention last week of the death of Mrs. Mamie Brandon at Laddonia, age 30 years, 10 months and 15 days. United with the Presbyterian church in the Fall of 1899 at Curryville, Missouri, under the pastorate of Rev. Elmore.

She married William Brandon, 26 November 1893 at Bowling Green, Missouri. Her husband and three children survive her. The funeral services were at the home, conducted by Rev. G. M. C. Okes of Frankford. Pallbearers were J. A. Pierce, John Bacik, E. C. Kennen, C. R. Wilder, L. W. McCoy, and Seth Mapes.
