This Indenture, made this twenty fourth day of May
in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty three Between
Franklin M. Chapman and Adeline M. Chapman his wife of the town of Shaw
county of Walworth and State of Wisconsin parties of the first part and Eliza A.
Bell of the town of Geneva county and State of Wisconsin party of the second part;
Witnesseth; That the said parties of the first part in consideration of the sum
of One thousand Dollars to them in hand paid by the said party of the second
part the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by their presents grant
 bargain sell and convey to the said party of the second part their heirs
 and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of Land, lying and being
 in the said town of Shaw and more particularly described as follows
 to wit: The North East quarter of Section Thirty One in Township No. One
 North of Range fifteen East in the District of Land subject to sale
 at Milwaukee Wisconsin containing one hundred and eighty acres
 according to the Official plat of the said Lands returned to the General
 Land Office by the Surveyor General together with all the here dit
 ament and appurtenances thereto or in any way appertaining;
 And the said Franklin M. Chapman party of the first part do covenant
 with the said party of the second part their heirs and assigns as follows; First
 that he is lawfully seized of said premises, and that he has good right to
 convey the same, and finds that the said party of the second part their heirs and
 assigns shall quietly enjoy and possess the same; and he will warrant and
 defend the title to the same against all lawful claims. Excepting a certain
 Lease given by said Franklin M. Chapman to Cyrus Chapman dated the tenth
 day of February eight hundred and fifty two, and a one cent
 mortgage given to Solomon Arnold for one hundred and twenty dollars
