### Biographical History

Roberta Wiley compiled books of her ancestors, with surname Maddox and allied families, and used these research materials for the contents of her books. Wiley is a descendant of Notley Maddox and Nancy Ann Freeman. Research started about 1957 with correspondence between Wiley and other Maddox descendants.

### Scope and Content

The records span the time period from 1640 to the 1800s. The records cover various surnames and family lines. Most records are copies of, or transcriptions of, wills, deeds, marriage bonds, and other materials.
