WOMAN DIES AT HOME SON HERE ILL FOR MONTHS

Mrs. Mamie Bryant of Alexandria, Lived With Son Here Nearly a Year; Funeral Arrangements Incomplete.

Mrs. Mamie Bryant of Alexandria died at the home of her son here, 1521 Avenue M, late Monday, after an extended illness. She has been living at the home of her son since the death of her husband in April, 1928.

Mrs. Bryant is survived by four sons, one sister and two brothers. The sons are Gene of Fort Madison, Oscar, Clyde and Marion of Alexandria; the brothers are Oscar Brandon of Cyrene, Mo., and Arthur Brandon of Colorado. The sister is Nellie Shepherd of Ashley, Mo.

She is also survived by 16 grandchildren and one great-grandchild. Funeral arrangements are incomplete, due to the high water that is still threatening the roads between Keokuk and Alexandria although it is known that services will take place at Keokuk Wednesday afternoon.

The funeral services for the late Mrs. Robert Bryant of Alexandria were held from the Christian church here yesterday afternoon at 1:30 o'clock with the Rev. James C. Leonard officiating.

The pallbearers were Ed. Seggelko, J. D. Rebo, William McFarlin, Frank Wood, John Winkelman and Sam Shultser. Interment was made in the Frazer cemetery south of Wayland.

Mrs. Robert Bryant died at the home of her son, G. W. Bryant, in Fort Madison, April 1, at the age of sixty-two years and eighteen days. She was a member of the Christian church for many years but for the past two years was a member of the Presbyterian church at Alexandria, Mo.

She was united in marriage with Robert Bryant on November 20, 1882. To this union five sons were born, one of whom died in infancy. Her husband preceded her in death on April 25, 1928.

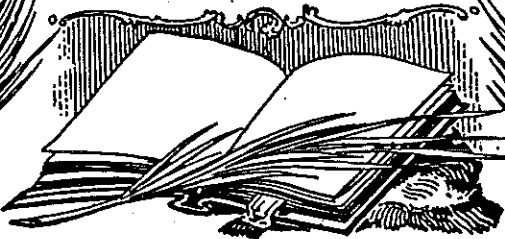
