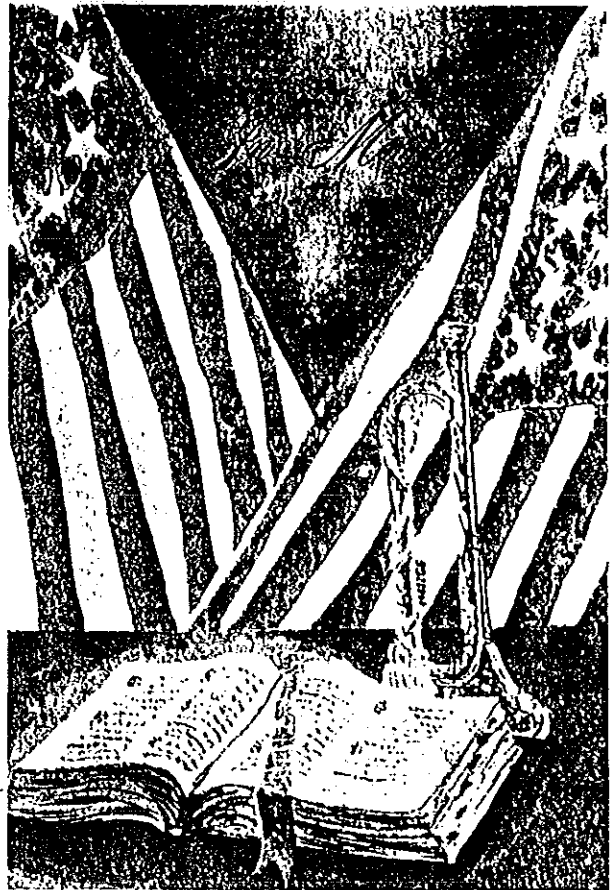

Jack C. Halderman, son of Ernest L. and Minnie Mae Hasenyager was born January 29, 1923 at Long Island, Kansas and passed away at the Lutheran Medical Center in Wheat Ridge, Colorado at the age of 60 years, 3 months and 23 days. *MAY 22 - 1983*
