Robert Dale Ward is interred in Desert Lawn Memorial Gardens, Kennewick, Washington. His wife, Ruth Mae, was born in Kossuth County, Algona, Iowa.

Hugh Eugene Ward's second wife, Marolyn was born at Cambridge, Ohio, 24 May 1922. Hugh served in the U.S. Navy during World War II. He was Construction Superintendent for 40 years.

Mary "Evelyn" Ward's profession was School Teacher. She taught in the Rural schools of Madison County, Iowa, for seven years. Also worked as a U.S. Government employee for 3 years during World War II at Ogden, Utah. She and husband, Clarence W. Chace, were married in the Trinity Methodist Church, Des Moines, IA. He enlisted in the Marine Corps the 17th of February, 1935 and served until the 25th of September, 1945. He was also an employee of the U.S. Government for twenty-four and a half years and from which he retired the 1st of November, 1969.
