M.W.: If I remember right, it was at a dance near Appleton City, Missouri, after the war and they were married there. Grand-dad never danced. He just went, he said, "To watch the girls hop around."

E.B.: I would like to have a list of the occupations and military service of all your boys.

M.W.: Dale or Harold, our oldest boy, was in limited service, never was out of the states. He worked in camp as a cook and butcher also as a ward helper in the hospital. During the last year he was in several camps in California. Then he worked in the army postoffice.

Calvin was in the occupational service in Germany for two years. He was a sergeant and that is all I know. They didn't like it so they don't talk much.
