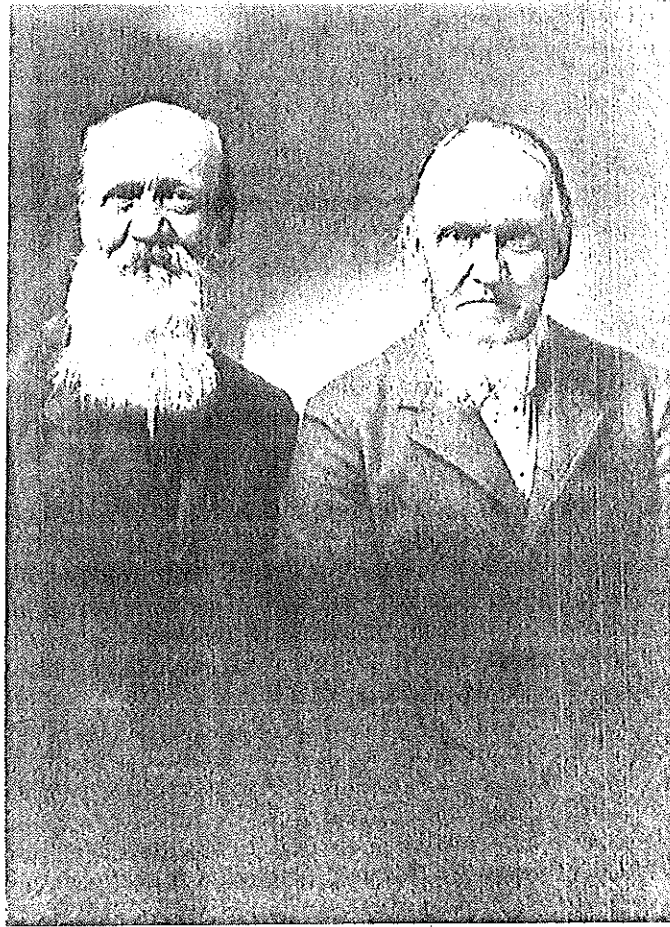

IN MEMORIAM

Of Robert A. MC CONNELL, who departed this life January 10, 1908, at his home near Louisville, Missouri, after a few days illness with paralysis. Mr. McConnell was born near Louisiana, Missouri, February 21, 1835. When he grew to manhood he was married to Miss Rachel Webb of Calhoun County, Illinois, in Clarksville, Missouri, January 6, 1856, by Esq. James Kincaid.

To this union 8 children were born, 2 dying in infancy, and a son dying at 6 years of age. A loving wife and 5 children survive him: F. A. McConnell of Nebo, Illinois, William H. and John M. of Louisville, Missouri, Mrs Sarah McConnell Scholl of Vandalia, Missouri, and Mrs. Viola McConnell LeMasters of Estes, Missouri.

He became a member of the Christian Church in Illinois before the Civil War, afterwards uniting with the Louisville Christian Church October 13, 1903, under the ministry of Elder J. D. Powell.

He was 72 years, 10 months and 19 days old, all his children were present with him in his last hours. This is a brief history of one who has fought the battle of life, grown weary with its buffeting and passed out into the life beyond. But how well his life work tells for itself, quiet and unassuming, honest and upright was the example he set before his family and neighbors, and no one can say aught of the life of this good man. It has often been remarked the devotion which he seemed to possess for his companion, and to look into the faces of this serene old couple in the calm evening of life was proof that whatever of shadow or sunshine, grief or joy, had come to them they had shared them together, and we believe trustingly so that the Divine Father would care for his children.

Their youngest son, John M., remained in the home with them and cared for his aged parents and now that father has gone to that home above and no longer needs the help of his dear boy, we are sure that the reward of duty well done is his, and there is One above who takes note of all that has brought self-denial and will abundantly repay.

In the family burying ground known as the Morriss Cemetery, (now called the Duncan - Gregory - Morriss Cemetery) after funeral services conducted in the home by Elder Hutchinson, Sunday, January 12, they placed his body to rest, knowing that in the resurrection, God's redeemed shall rise and be forever with Him in the Heavenly City prepared for those who trust in Him.
