In 1900 Census Index Henry is found in Bluffdale Precinct of Greene Co., Illinois with wife, Sarah and their daughter, Beulah, who is 8 mos. old.

Henry is found in the 1880 census of Bluffdale Precinct of Greene County at the age of 9 and is with his parents and three brothers. It is likely that this is where Henry was born.

I did not find Henry & family listed in the 1910 census index of either Illinois or Missouri. There is no index for Iowa.

I viewed the Bluffdale Precinct portion of Greene County, IL, 1910 census but did not find Henry recorded therein.
