WITNESSETH, that the said part 1st of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Six hundred and 75/100 DOLLARS, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said part 2^d of the second part, his

heirs and assigns, all the following described real estate, situated in the County of Harper and State of Kansas, to wit: All of Block number twenty five (25) in Bluff City, Kansas according to original Plat thereof

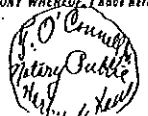

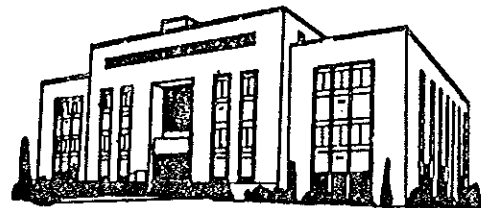
