Know all men by these presents, that we Joseph H. Burbridge as principal and John Jordan as his security, are held and firmly bound unto the State of Missouri, in the full and just sum of four hundred dollars lawful money of the United States, to which payment will and truly to be made to and for the use of Emily Burbridge minor hereinafter named and mentioned, we bind ourselves, our heirs, our Executors and administrators, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents. The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas Joseph Burbridge above named, has at the May (1839) term of the County court, for the county of Pike been appointed guardian of the estate of the above named Emily Burbridge, a minor of the age of fourteen years and five months, now if the Said Joseph H. Burbridge above bounden shall well and truly and faithfully discharge the duties of his office, as guardian aforesaid, according to law, then this obligation to be void else to remain in full force and virtue. Dated and sealed at Bowling Green, this 6<sup>th</sup> day of May 1839.
