Funeral services for William Thomas Brandon 77, of 715 1/2 North Grand avenue east, who died at 1 a. m. yesterday at St. John's sanitarium following an illness of two years, will be held at 2 p. m. tommorrow at the Vancil funeral home. Rev. D. J. Finley will officiate and burial will be in Roselawn cemetery.

Mr. Brandon, a retired coal miner, was born Dec. 12, 1866, in Johnson county, Mo. and had resided here 35 years. He married Miss Effie Cobb in 1894. He was a member of the Christian church, Vandalia, Mo.

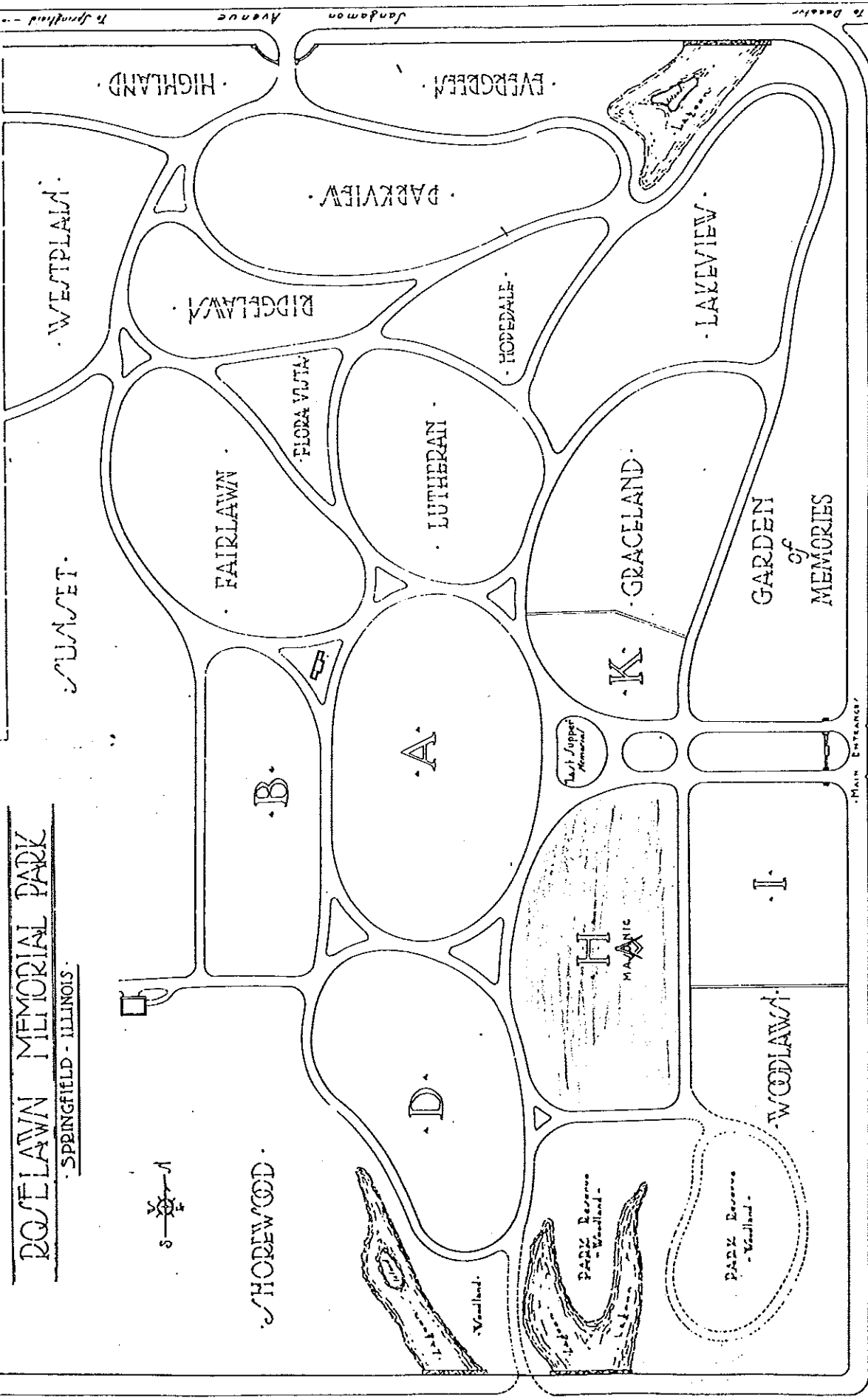
