- My mother Frances Cravens died Oct. 12<sup>th</sup> 1843
- Nelson Faulconer died Jan. 1857  
(note, son of Joseph Faulconer, Rev. soldier, Pensioned  
in Fayette Co. Ky. Pension papers mention son  
Nelson)
- Elizabeth Faulconer, my mother, died April 21<sup>st</sup> 1830
- John Cravens, my brother, died May 2<sup>nd</sup> 1845
- William Cravens died December 4<sup>th</sup> 1847 on Saturday
- Sally Jane Cravens died August 4<sup>th</sup> 1842
- Joseph T. Cravens died August 8<sup>th</sup> 1842
- Died in Clay Co. Mo. Nov. 16<sup>th</sup> 1864 Milton Cravens
- Died in Clay Co. Mo. Sept. 12<sup>th</sup> 1867 (Wm. F. Cravens)
- Died in Clay Co. Mo. May 29<sup>th</sup> 1875 Thomas W. Cravens
- Died in Mo. City, Clay Co. Mo. Sep. 20<sup>th</sup> 1868 Rebecca

(Note. This Bible originally belonged to  
William and Rebecca Crarens, <sup>Kentucky</sup> After William's  
death Rebecca married his nephew, Milton Crarens  
and came from Kentucky to Missouri about 1855  
bringing this Bible with them).
