The ages of their children here are in question because in the 1850 census Caroline is 10 years old and Samuel is only 4. Phebe, who is 13 here does not even appear in the 1850 census. Their ages as recorded by one of these Ass't Marshals has to be in error. If Caroline is the eldest it would seem to be a possibility she was the one girl under the age of 5 in the 1840 census record of William Carlin &amp; family.</p>
