# DIES SUDDENLY

1906 Young Man, Apparently  
Good Health, Sudden-  
ly Falls Dead.

The people of Story City and vicinity were greatly shocked Wednesday on hearing of the sudden death of Frank Doolittle. Wednesday morning about nine o'clock, while assisting Ed. Slin in the moving of his household goods Frank suddenly fell to the ground and, almost instantly, expired. Medical assistance was immediately summoned and found his death due to heart failure. His health hasn't been of the best for some time and it was known to members of the family that his heart was affected. This disease was no doubt inherited from his father who died at Ames, very suddenly from heart trouble about seven years ago.

The funeral services will be held at the home to-morrow morning at nine o'clock, conducted by Rev. Verger. The remains will be taken to Ames for interment.

Frank was a young man, not quite nineteen years of age, and was a student of the Story City High School which he has been attending the past year. He was a youth of excellent qualities and formed many friendships in the community in which he lived and among his schoolmates. The sorrowing family has the sympathy of all.
