Notes: - The progenitor of the Couwen
family in America was Wolghert
Barntsen Van Couwenhoven, who came
from Holland. He had a son Peter,
born in Holland about 1614, who, with
his father and other children emigrated
to New York about 1630. He married
second, Nov. 2, 1665 Aelje Lybrant, a
widow by his second marriage he had,
among other children, Peter, bapt.
Feb. 27, 1669. This ... of the line settled
in Great Egg Harbor, Gloucester Co. N. J.
his will, dated Sept. 30, 1700 and proved
Mar. 21, 1704 mentions wife Mary;
children John, David, Heber, who married
Richard Paisley of St. Egg Harbor.
