DR. FREDERICK WESLEY PARK OBITUARY

Frederick Wesley Park, son of Wesley and Jennie E. Parks, was born Oct. 23, 1866, at Fieldon, Ill. and resided here until death. On March 15, 1890, he graduated from Beaumont Medical College of St. Louis, Mo., and began practice on March 17, 1890, has been practicing

19 years, March 17, 1909.

On May 27, 1895, he was united in marriage to Miss Amanda A. Dayton, to this union was born one son, Ward F. Parks, who now survives.

On Dec. 14, 1897, his wife died leaving the young husband and infant child to mourn their loss.

On Oct. 7, 1901, he was again united in marriage to Miss Stella Combs, who now survives.

On Monday, May 3, 1909, he was taken ill with complication of disease, and was abandoned until death came to relieve him at 7:30 p. m., May 7, 1909, aged 42 years, 6 months and 16 days.

He leaves to mourn their loss his kind, affectionate wife, who was by his side constantly through his sickness and who is well loved by every one who knows her, one son, Ward F. Park, his father, Dr. Wesley Park, his step mother, Mrs. Ella Park, and half sister, Miss Ethel Park of Graton, Ill., two brothers, George Park of Jerseyville and Arthur Park of Fieldon, his mother having preceded him in death Oct. 17, 1905. He also leaves a great number of other relatives and a multitude of friends.

He was a kind hearted, affectionate husband and father, he stood among the prominent physicians of the county. He will be missed greatly as a professional man, as his presence seemed to inspire hope in that of the patient. He will also be missed as a business man and neighbor as he was kind hearted and congenial to every one with whom he met. His funeral was one of the largest ever held in Bloxwoods Township. It was a very sad funeral as every one seemed to feel his loss most keenly.

He was a member of M. W. A. and M. P. L. at Fieldon, the M. W. A. took charge of the funeral at the cemetery, which was beautifully conducted. Both orders remembered him with wreaths of flowers. The M. W. A. marched in a body from the house to the church and then to the cemetery.

Dr. Park's funeral was not an elaborate one for the reason that he was a plain man and did not like to be mourned and buried.

Services were held in the Cumberland Presbyterian Church. Officiating clergymen were Rev. F. V. Wright, formerly of East St. Louis who now resides in Fieldon, Ill., assisted by Rev. R. Russell of Fieldon, Rev. Crawford of Kane, and Rev. Belt of Jerseyville. Interment was made at Fieldon cemetery. The family has the hearty sympathy of all the community.

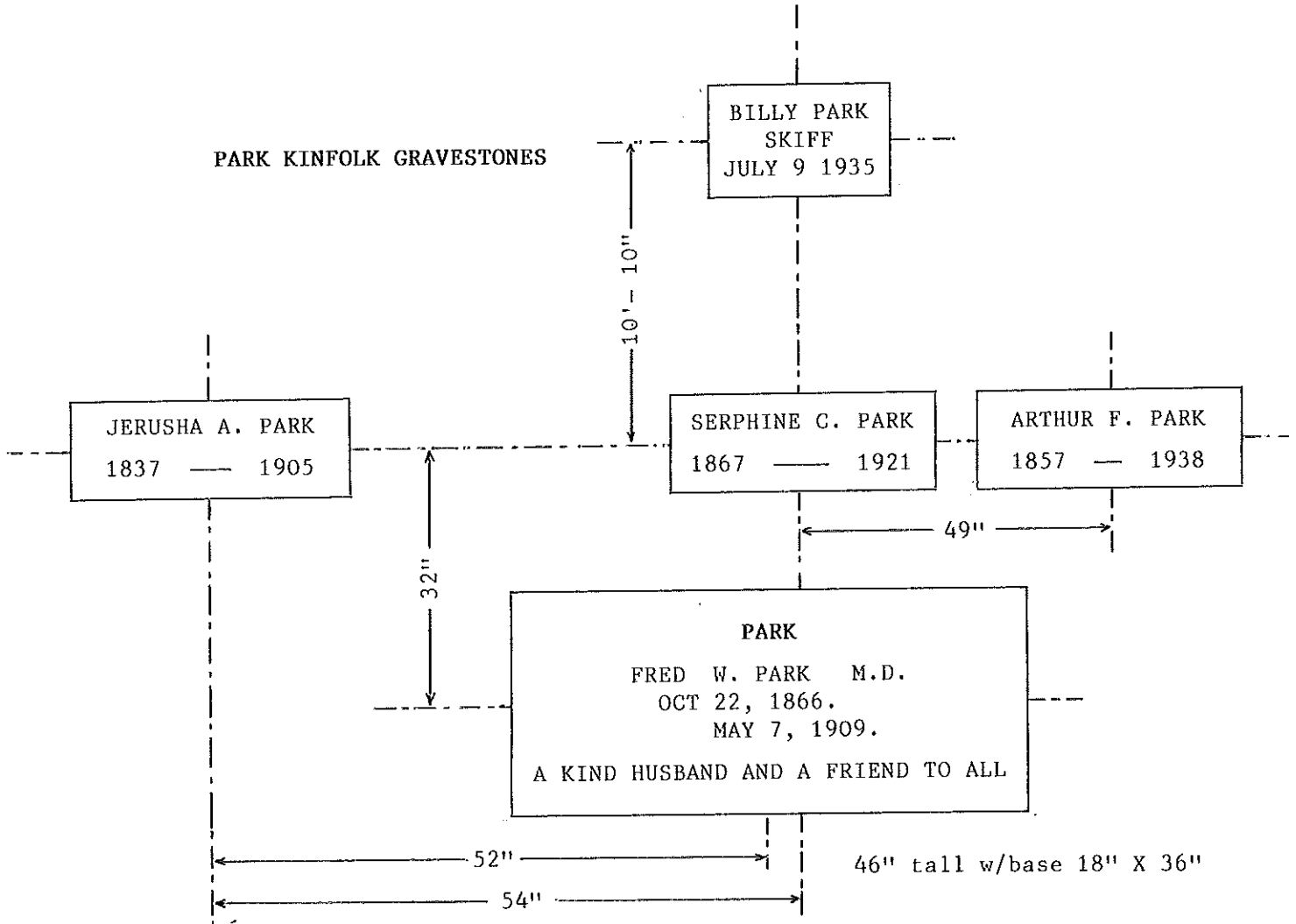

**MOTORCYCLIST WHOSE SKULL WAS
FRACTURED IN COLLISION, DIES**

Ward Park, St. Louis County, who was severely injured at 12:15 a. m., July 4, when a motorcycle on which he and Robert Felso, also residing in the county, were riding ran into the rear of an automobile at Union and Thekla avenues, died this morning at the City Hospital from his injuries.

The automobile in the collision was owned and driven by Benjamin Hagreman, 37 years old, residing at 5097 Ruskin avenue. Felso was but slightly bruised. Park suffered a compound fracture of the skull.
