

Lt. John Q. Burbridge of Bowling Green acting with a small band seized the state's arms that had been received on June 18, 1861, sent from St. Louis on the steamer "Hawkeye State". Eventually John Q. Burbridge became colonel of the Fourth Missouri Cavalry which took part in the Battle of Westport in Jackson County, Missouri. (Oct. 21-23, 1864)

page 609
The Sidwells of Pike County originally came from Bourbon County, Kentucky. Elisha and Mary Case Sidwell were married 2 October 1792 in Bourbon County. They were both born during the 1760s, all their children were born in Kentucky. They came to Pike County in the fall of 1827. In the 1830 Pike County Census there were three families living here, Elisha with 9 members, Joshua with 6 members and John with 10 members. Many of the Sidwells are buried in the Sidwell Cemetery in the Southeast part of Buffalo Township, others in Dover Cemetery in Calumet Township.

page 652 Jane Vance married Robert McConnell, the son of William McConnell in 1820.

Mrs. Charles (Charlene) Buffum, Jr. supplied early day pictures of Louisiana, Missouri.
