On June 9, 1864, the regiment left Quincy and proceeded to Memphis, Tenn., where it was assigned to the 4th Brigade, District of Memphis, Col. E. L. Bottwish, of Wisconsin, commanding.

On July 9 it was assigned to 3^d Brigade, Col. John Wood, commanding, and was stationed on the Hernando Road on pick-et duty.

The regiment was mustered out of the U.S. service at Springfield, Illinois, September 4, 1864.
