Charles M. Halderman, prominent citrus rancher of Santa Ana and Tustin, Calif., for the past 37 years, died Friday morning, September 6, 1940, at St. Joseph hospital after an illness of two weeks at the age of 83. He was born in Ohio and came to Long Island, Kansas, as one of the pioneer settlers in the community two miles northwest of town where he was married to Eliza Pillsbury and where he made his home until 1903 when they moved to Tustin, Calif. While he lived here as well as after he moved to California, both he and Mrs. Halderman were active workers in the Methodist church and insisted that all members of the family attend divine services at least once each Sunday. He was also instrumental in getting many of his relatives and neighbors to become regular attendants and furnished transportation for a part of them who were not able to get there otherwise. Mrs. Halderman finished her earthly work here and went to her home about a year and a half ago. He is survived by six sons and two daughters; Barrett L. of Santa Ana; Earl F. of Keams Canyon, Arizona; Leonard P. of Anaheim, Calif; Clarence W. of Indian Wells, Arizona; Myron E. of Ventura, California; Levi G. of Wasco, California; and Mrs. U. G. Halderman of Tustin, California. Two brothers, George and Augustus E. Halderman of Long Island, Kansas, and a sister, Mrs. Alda Leach of Santa Ana also survive him. Funeral services were held at 2 p. m., Saturday, September 7th, at the Winbigler mortuary with the Rev. Calvin E. Holman officiating. Entombment was made in the Fairhaven mausoleum.

1857

Mrs. Eliza Bragdon Halderman passed away at her home in Santa Ana, California, on January 3, 1939 after several weeks of illness. Funeral services were conducted by her pastor, Dr. Calvin E. Holman and she was laid to rest in the beautiful mausoleum in Fairhaven Cemetery near Santa Ana.

Eliza Bragdon Pillsbury was born March 2, 1861 at Dover, New Hampshire, and here she received her education and grew to young womanhood. About this time her parents felt the urge to pioneer and she went with them to make her home in Kansas. After a short sojourn in eastern Kansas the family settled in Phillips county. Here she met her life companion, Charles M. Halderman, and they were united in marriage on January 7, 1884 at Long Island, Kansas.

A short time after their marriage this young couple attended a revival meeting and were both converted and united with the Methodist Church of Long Island. Living on a farm in pioneer day in western Kansas meant that church privileges were not as common as now and as children came to bless the home there was not the opportunity for a considerable amount of church work. However, the spirit of the living Christ was in the heart of this pioneer mother and with her New England background she developed a gracious Christian character, a blessing not only to her family but to all who knew her.

In 1903 the family moved to Santa Ana, California, and now with the children able to help with some of the work and with the church services more accessible, Mrs. Halderman began a period of her life that was to be marked with earnestness and zeal in the work of all the church organizations. Her whole interest was built around her family and the church. She could truly say with the apostle, "For me to live is Christ." While her activity was as wide as the interests of the

church itself, her deepest concern was for the David and Margaret Missionary Group and the Belgian Bible Class, of which she was a member. She was never content to be idle but always busy about some interest of her religion.

Living an active busy life, she was especially blessed with good health and on the first day of her illness commented on the fact that she had not been ill in bed for thirty years. She was on the way home from a church service when her illness first became apparent. The next day it seemed certain that her heart could not carry her through and she called her pastor in to pray and then in a beautiful prayer of her own committed herself and her family to God. She lingered for several weeks after that, but there was no complaint for she knew in whom she had committed her all and gladly awaited the summons when He finally called. As she had lived, so she died, rejoicing greatly in Christ and counting it all joy to fellowship with Him.

#### Personal Thumbnail Sketch

I took an early retirement in 1979 from the Physical Education teaching staff (Professor) of Calif. St. Polytechnic Univ. in Pomona, CA. (Early retirement? I return and teach one quarter each year) We built a home in Carson City after several visits with friends here. Now we enjoy visiting old ghost towns, looking for bottles and coins.

Deedi and Heidi just spent 10 weeks in Europe on the most Economic plan. Heidi (at 32) had just graduated from Cal. ST. Univ. Sacramento. Our son John (28) is a Registered Nurse at the Carson City Hospital. Next week, I receive my homebuilt aircraft kit and will start work on it for two months before returning to teach for three months. Upon completion of the airplane (about one year), Deedi and I plan to do quite a bit of traveling around the U.S.
