Baruch Dorr, b 30 June 1777, CT; d 4 March 1842, Porter Co., IN; s/o Captain Matthew and Lydia Wood McLean Dorr; m 1 June 1809 Licking Co., OH Phoebe Ward, b 21 Feb. 1788 Rockingham Co., VA; d 22 April 1877, Westville, Porter Co., IN; d/o Jonas and Phoebe Ward.

"Baruch Dorr (1778-1842) came with his parents to Marietta, Ohio, in 1795. Two years later he was one of the first party of settlers to arrive in what is now Athens County. In June of the same year his parents removed to Waterford up the Muskingum River.

"It was there that Baruch Dorr met the attractive little Phoebe Ward (then only eleven years of age) daughter of Jonas and Phoebe Ward who came from Rockingham County, Virginia to Waterford on the Muskingum in 1797. (See #15 Dewese lineage. The husband of Elizabeth Dewese, Jonas Ward, Jr., was a brother of Phoebe Ward.)

"Baruch and his brothers Edmund and William settled in Athens County and persuaded their parents to remove there also which they did in 1798 and located near Wolf's Plains (now called 'The Plains').

"A few years later Jonas Ward removed with his family to Licking County, Ohio.

"Baruch, unable to forget Phoebe, traced the Wards to Licking County and there he married her on June 1, 1809. She was born in Rockingham County, Virginia, Feb. 21, 1788 and died at Westville, Porter County, IN, on Apr. 22, 1877.

"Baruch returned with his bride to Athens County where they resided until the autumn of 1835 when they journeyed overland to Porter County, In, where they resided until death.

"They had twelve children, all of whom were born in Athens County, Ohio.

"He died Mar. 4, 1842 and his will is of record in Porter County, In. Will Book A, pp. 7 and 8 and is as follows:

I Baruch Dorr, considering the uncertainty of this mortal life and being of sound mind and memory (blessed be Almighty God for the same) do make and publish this my last will and Testament, in manner and form following that is to say:

First, I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Phebe Dorr during her natural life, the use of my real and personal estate, Second, my three daughters, Helena, Julian and Lavina Dorr or either of them, shall receive equally of the avails of the above mentioned estate, during their remaining single and staying at home. The real estate shall belong eventually to my three youngest sons: Jonathan L, Jonas and Joseph Dorr, upon condition they continue cultivating the same, if either of them die, their share of the real estate shall be equally divided among my proper heirs, not leaving it in the power of either of them to sell or convey in any way any part of the real estate to any but one of the heirs.

Third I appoint Russell Dorr, Edward Dorr, Henry Herrold administrators in conjunction with my wife to transact business, give advice, set off dowers to any of my daughters at their discretion and settle disputes. This being my last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all former wills by me made. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 20th day of August, in the year of our Lord on thousand eight hundred and thirty-nine.

- Page 213 Portage Township received its name from a county in the state of Ohio. It was organized at the time of the general division of the territory of the (Porter) county in 1836.
- Page 215 Early Conditions
Probably the first marriage was that of Henry Harold to Miss Dorr.
- Page 216 The churches. -- The first church built was the Presbyterian in 1852, at a cost of about \$800. Mr. S. P. Robbins built the church and furnished all the requisite materials and money except about \$160. One hundred dollars was furnished by the missionary fund of the church and about sixty dollars was raised by subscriptions. After it was completed Mr. Robbins deeded it to the trustees. The following are the names of some of those who helped to organize the church: S. P. Robbins and wife, Benjamin Stoddard and wife, Francis James, Emily James, Russell Dorr and wife, Daniel Richardson, Mr. Leters and sister, and others. Rev. James C. Brown was the first minister. Rev. Humphrey and Rev. Ogden are the only other regular ministers that the church has had.
- Page 217 First Settlers and First Elections
In the spring of 1834 at the same time came Berrett* Dorr and family. Two of the boys, Russell and Edmund, were of age at the time.
The first election of the township was held April 30th at the house of Jacob Wolf, with James Spurlock as Inspector. At an election held at the house of Jacob Wolf, Portage Township, on the first Monday in August, 1836 the following persons polled their votes: Russell Dorr B. Dorr.
- Page 120 Valparaiso and Centre Townships
Mr. W. H. Holabird, about 1871, began the manufacture of shooting suits and in a year or two established the enterprise here. His suits attained a wide notoriety, and the sales became large. His health required him to engage in other pursuits, and the business is now in the hands of Upthegrove & McLellan, who employ on an average fifteen hands, and have a large trade.
- Page 25 County Commissioners. --- Russel Dorr, 1843-44.
